

Yarmouk University recognizes the importance of stakeholder participation in decision-making at various levels and is committed to informing them of decisions related to all of its work. It has recently approved a transparency policy, which includes the following principles:

- 1.1 The university is committed to transparency and declares it in its values.
- 1.2 The university is committed to establishing internal work procedures that include the organizational units indexing, documenting, and classifying information and documents (secret classified documents, protected classified documents, regular documents) by the university's policy of classifying and documenting information and documents.
- 1.3 The university publishes all regular information and documents through printed materials and/or on its website, provided that they are up-to-date, complete, and easily accessible by stakeholders.
- 1.4 The university must respond to requests submitted by stakeholders regarding providing them with information and regular documents completely, clearly, and within the legal time limit stipulated by the law guaranteeing the right to access information in force.
- 1.5 The university is committed to withholding some information in specific and carefully recorded cases.
- 1.6 The university is committed to reviewing the implementation of this policy periodically and making the necessary improvements to it.
- 1.7 All stakeholders must read and abide by this policy, its procedures, and its appendices and any updates made to it, under penalty of accountability.
