The two prime ministers of the Jordanian government were chosen, namely Prof. Dr. Adnan Badran - the first president of Yarmouk University and its founder, and Dr. Hani Al-Mulki, a faculty member at Al-Hijjawi College), and to this day it still includes in its formation Dr. Muhammad Al-Momani, Minister of State for Media Affairs, in addition to many members of the Jordanian House of Representatives.
