Therefore, the University of Yarmouk realizes through its vision and mission to identify the risks of corruption through the development and completion of the structure of the university's administrative organ and to activate management quality systems and excellence in government performance to develop an efficient and effective administrative body through the application of the system of integrity and transparency in line with the national anti-corruption strategy. The university provides high-quality services to its members through the activation of transparency and integrity mechanisms in the units within the university; In addition to activating the government complaints system and updating judicial procedures to achieve full justice. Organizing student initiatives and seminars to raise awareness of the risks and dangers of corruption to society, as well as training courses for faculty and staff on integrity, transparency, and combating corruption. It also recognizes the students' union in university colleges and provides outreach, education, skills development, and capacity-building services in the fields of economy, law, technology, climate change, etc., as well as providing platforms for dialogue and exchange of ideas and opinions. The University of Yarmouk therefore seeks to promote the rule of law, human rights, peace and justice, the rejection of violence and conflict, the establishment of the norms of security, and the elimination of all forms of
